



Pinwheel Card

Materials:

- Pinwheel Sizzlit
 - Subtle DSP (Bashful Blue, So Saffron, Certainly Celery)
 - Mini Glue Dots
 - Subtle brads
 - Stripes embossing folder
 - Big Shot
1. Cut card stock (in order):
 - a. Baja Breeze: 4.5 x 5.25
 - b. So Saffron: 4.25 x 5
 - c. Very Vanilla: 4 x 4.75
 2. Using DSP, run pinwheel sizzlit through the Big Shot (die cutting machine)
 3. Assemble pinwheels
*** Use a paper piercer or long needle to assist in assembly. Put needle through middle hole first, then tread each hole onto needle. HOLD ALL POINTS TOGETHER WITH YOUR THUMB AS I SHOWED YOU, then remove needle. Insert brad & fasten closed. ***
 4. Assemble pieces of card stock together & attach pinwheels
 5. Stamp sentiment as desired, and adhere
